- Can prepare most types of media material in digital form
- Can employ the principal methods in the processing and finishing of images for publication on a web, and co-ordinate text and images
- Knows proper working practices in the use of software and tools primarily used in the construction and maintenance of a
 website and web-related materials
- Can use the most common types of software used in the construction and maintenance of a website
- Is familiar with the principal computer and technical equipment on which networks and websites are run
- Knows how to use handbooks and web materials to obtain information about machinery and software
- Knows about the main types of websites, what they do and how they are constructed
- Knows the premise behind the protection of web media data

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

A web technician undertakes website construction for small- and medium-sized enterprises. He or she gathers materials and edits, plans the look and activity of a web, constructs it for publication on the Internet or company intranet, and promotes its content.
