3. DESCRIPTION OF KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

The holder

- Knows the main qualities and workings of materials used in paper hanging and floor laying and is aware of potential dangers associated with their use and the environmental effects they may have
- Is aware of and knows the correct application of all main machinery and tools that paper hangers and floor layers use in their work
- Is familiar with safety regulations in the workplace and conducts his or her work in such a way that the health and safety of self and others is not at risk
- Is able to lay linoleum and floor plates in dry spaces indoors
- Is able to lay carpet on floors and stairs indoors
- Is able to lay wall and ceiling materials in dry spaces indoors
- Can create decorative bands or pictures and insert into linoleum
- Can lay linoleum on floors, walls and ceilings in wet rooms
- · Can lay specialised linoleum, canvas, plates and veneer, both outdoors and indoors
- Can repair damage and renew floor, wall and ceiling surfaces
- Knows the basics of colour and form and the main style periods

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The work of paper hangers and floor layers consists primarily of selecting materials based on the relevant conditions, their unique qualities and the wishes of the customer, precise preparatory work, such as cleaning and repairing a work surface, and the completion of the work through the laying of the relevant wall or floor materials. This trade sector incorporates most things that are affixed with glue into human dwellings, such as wallpaper, decorative bands, canvas, and other materials placed on ceilings and walls. Paper hangers and floor layers also lay carpets, linoleum and floor tiles, as well as various soundproofing materials. An important part of the trade is the laying of floor and wall materials in wet rooms, e.g. bathrooms and industrial premises. Some paper hangers and floor layers specialise in laying artificial surfaces on sports fields, in sports stadiums, swimming pools and on roofs. Authorised to work as paper hangers and floor layers are those who have earned a journeyman's certificate in paper hanging and floor laying, issued by the Minister of Industry and Trade.

This document is designed to provide additional information about the specified certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. 6. FRAMEWORK AND ORGANISATION OF TRAINING

The average duration of the education and training programme is four years, organised as follows: formal education for three school terms, or 54 weeks including examinations, and 120 weeks of on-the-job training. The programme concludes with a journeyman's examination.
