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# What is BORE?

- 16 month project
  - ✓ project period: 1. Nov 2014 30 April 2016
- Estimated cost: 56.367 €
- Grant: 45.093 € (6,75 mio ISK)
- Two main objectives:
  - I. Student-centred learning
  - II. International dimension
- Target Group: educational authorities; leaders within higher education institutions (faculty heads; those responsible for educational development within the HEI, counsellors); students (potential students)





#### **BORE Objective** *student-centred learning (1)*

Extract from application:

• "the objective of BORE is to firmly put in place student-centred learning, in particular ensure the practical application of the learning outcomes approach and sustaining the outcomes of institutional quality reviews which started in 2011. This objective will be achieved through different activities and measures......These activities will further be linked to a review of the procedures and practices of the National HE Quality Council in 2015."





## **BORE Objective** *student-centred learning (2)*

- Increased quality in higher education:
  - Quality in higher education a policy priority in Iceland...and in Europe.
  - ✓ IS HE Quality Board; revision of operational procedures; focus areas
  - Quality assurance closely linked to implementation of learning outcomes which is key to implementing ECTS, and ensuring recognition of qualifications
- BORE Objective:
  - Follow-up on review of curricula and quality reviews => increase diversity of participants in this process within HEIs (heads of faculty/departments; students) => organise training (participation of Nordic experts)





#### **BORE Objective** *international dimension of HE (1)*

- "Icelandic HEIs and decsions-makers need to focus more attention on the international dimension and on creating opportunities for students to be mobile during their studies.....outbound credit mobility numbers are stagnating [and] there is no national strategy for supporting the international dimension.
- In the short-term the objective is to engage stakeholders in a dialogue on the international dimension and <u>develop</u> recommendations for decision-makers at national and institutional level on developing strategies and in facilitating the integration of mobility windows in more study programmes.

The long-term objective for mobility is to increase the number of outgoing students...and improve the quality of the mobility experience."

### **BORE Objective** *international dimension of HE (2)*

#### • Focus: International Dimension in HE

- Student mobility plays a role in improving quality of eduation; supports personal development; increases employability
- Icelanders traditionally educated in high numbers abroad while degree mobility to Iceland traditionally low: proportionally fewer Icelanders in degree programmes abroad after 2008; incoming credit mobility students twice as many as outgoing; student composition changed much in last decade.
- No national policy in place about the international dimension; less than half of IS HEIs have a policy on internationalisation

#### BORE Objective:

- Increase opportunities for student mobility and increase support measures/qulity of student mobility => put forward recommendations
- Facilitate dialogues/brainstorming sessions with stakeholders on formulation of a policy on the international dimension => put forward recommendations.
