## INCLUSION GRANTS?

Top up grants are € 250\* a month on top of the regular Erasmus+ grant. Available for various

reasons

\*If the stay is shorter than a month, the amount is lower



Students who are immigrants or their descendants

Students who are refugees

Students who have or have had serious or lengthy physical or mental health challenges

Students with physical or mental disabilities, visual, hearing, or learning impairments

Students facing economic barriers

Students living in rural areas



Students with children under 18



In addition, funding is also available for actual costs: e.g. to transport assistive devices, obtain accessible housing, have an assistant or a sign language interpreter.
