# Inter Institutional Agreements (IIA) – state of play

- •Start renewing digital IIA:s as soon as possible from June 2021 by connecting to the Erasmus Without Paper-network.
- •IIA:s should be renewed digitally at the latest before the start of the first mobilities of the 2022/2023 academic year.
- •Current IIA:s are valid for mobilities taking place in the 2021/2022 academic year.
  - Some exceptions to digitally renewing IIA:s
  - Use paper versions for...
    - Partners with United Kingdom
    - Multilateral agreements, i.e within EUI and Nordplus
    - Other partnerships outside of Erasmus+ programme countries

# Your Roadmap/Time frame

•Set up a time frame/ roadmap according to your process timetable

• Look at it together with the commissions time frame

•Think about what to do with partners who cannot make your time frame

•Short version of University of Helsinki's time frame for EWP functions:

#### • May 2021

Testing DLA for outgoing students

Agreeing on ISCED codes used at the UH, and technical details for filling in IIA:s, levels for IIA:s testing, signing rights etc.

#### June 2021

Start using DLA for our outgoing students and testing it for incoming students Work-shop for staff initiating the IIA:s at UH

Start to use Mobility Online for IIA agreements

#### August 2021

DLA for incoming students

#### January 2022

Final student exchange IIA signed digitally for the call 2022-2023, Teacher agreements done adhoc 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 on as a broad base as possible.

# Internal procedures – Bergen

Will use the Erasmus+ Dashboard

Evaluation of current agreements – deadline 1. June

- 900 agreements
- Decentralized model: division of work central level vs. Faculties
- Negotiation of conditions via e-mail

Evaluation criterias:

- Knowledge and experience with partner university
- Course offers, language of teaching, courses in English, capacity etc.

Signing procedures

### Internal procedures -Mittuniversitet

1. Preparation by the IRO - currently

• Prepare lists of current partners and mobility statistics; initial analysis

 Initial plan for dialogues with the departments- who will be involved (head of dept, program managers, departmental coordinators), timeline

 Webinar- inform about process, timeline, things to consider (eg courses offered for incomings)

2. Dialogues with the departments- start asap, finished by September.

**3. Renewal process with partners-** start in June- agreements negotiated by IRO and/or dept., signed by the Deans.

#### 4. Communication with partners where we don't renew the agreements

 Agreements entailing multiple subjects, where some subjects are renewed and some not

## Internal procedures – Iceland

- -Centralised International Office sign everything
- -Working group established to review agreements late 2019
- Criteria:
  - Active agreement? Balance?
  - Enough courses taught in English? For outgoing/incoming
  - Special connections between the universities, e.g. between teachers?
  - Ranking? As a whole and individual faculty?
  - Do we run a programme in English that caters especially to incoming exchange students?

- Recommendations sent to faculties, they can argue against it. Staff agreements recommended.

- Faculties have now received the recommendations for subject specific agreements. Most faculties have responded and most agree.

- Hope to be able to only use the Dashboard to send out agreements.

### Dashboard IIAM

Digital solution via the Erasmus Dashboard

Agreement consists of two parts (as previously):

- The agreement
- Default IIA Data (annexe C-F)
- Possibility of csv upload

Comments field:

- Clarification on subject field (ISCED codes)
- The terms of agreement

Important to remember

- ISCED codes standard codes to facilitate transfer to other systems
- Contact person for the agreement
- How to know if and what changes are made by partner

Testing is possible until 31. May – from 1. June is the real thing!

## Connection via third-party

- •The same information is transfered between the different systems
  - Check what extra your provider provides and how you can use that information ton for you internal structure/administration
- •Have an open dialouge with your provider and partners using the same provider
- •Check your data in the system (ISCED 2013 codes, University structure etc.)
- •Share and update your general IIA information (Default IIA data)
- •Check how test agreements can be delted in your system, try testing with users of different solutions
