# Signing procedures

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Use the opportunities that come with digitalisation to rethink your internal procedures – look for opportunities

## ■ **Changes at University of Iceland**

- Used to require 2 signatures, one from academic head of programme and one from administrative staff
  - OLA offers only the possibility to have one person sign!
  - Now students talk to the academic and send an email with the approved courses to the administrative staff member who signs the OLA
- Used to require students to hand in a signed learning agreement at the time of exchange
  - Now we have no deadline – preferably before departure
  - Host universities often cancelled the agreement if they received it early
  - Now students should only do the OLA when they have the correct course info – less changes during the mobility

# Connection to 3rd party provider

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Do you use a third party provider?

- Digital Learning Agreement (DLA) mandatory -> not OLA
- EWP-connection key for the system, however you can start to prepare before connection
  - OLA template available and can be used as something to build on
- Keep an active dialog with your provider, ask for updates and timelines
- Possible to start using OLA and then take in to use DLA later
