Confirm, where applicable, whether synergies were achieved across different fields of education and training. Consider whether the project managed to bring forth "positive and long-lasting effects" for the RELEVANCE: the extent to which the project reinforced the participating organisations. Comment on the relevance of the project (actions, activities, outputs and/or outcomes) to the products and services already provided by partners and to the target capacities and international groups and audiences they work with.
